## Arizona Academic Standards Used (Kim James, 2007)

**Introduction:** General education teachers typically must have the standards for activities clearly posted and visible, to support teacher and student learning. In special education classrooms, it is important to have a clear listing of standards so that teachers, aides, therapists, and families are all on the same page. Knowing the standards that are linked to an activity can help 'kick it up a notch,' with all educators supporting in maximizing cognitive engagement for each activity.

#### READING STANDARDS

### **Kindergarten Reading Standard: Strand 1: Reading Process: Concept 1: Print Concepts:**

- PO 1: Recognize that print represents spoken language by finding own name and/or matching name to photo.
- PO 2: Hold a book right side up and turn pages in the correct direction.
