WHAT IS WRITER'S BINGO?

In The Write Genre, (2004), Rog and Kropp suggest using Writing Bingo to support students in setting topics. This strategy is an enjoyable way to help students think about topics that they might otherwise not have considered. The graphic shows a writing bingo form shared by Rog and Kropp. Their form presents a range of topic starters such as:

- holidays (My favorite holiday was . . .)
- scary things (Something that once scared me was . . .)
- accidents and injuries (I got this scar from . . .)

WRITING: Using Writing Bingo For Topic Setting

Use this Writing Bingo form to help students develop ideas that can serve as future writing topics. Many teachers have students keep their Writing Bingo forms in their journal, to be pulled out on a day that they 'can't think of anything to write.'

Creating New Bingo Forms

For some students, 16 starters are overwhelming. Thus, we have created simplified forms, such as the one on the left, that offer fewer choices, and support beginning writers, whose print is larger. The form on the right was created to support students in writing a memoir for Mother's Day.
